

# Terms & Conditions

Documents A valid passport is required for entry into the BVI.

Children : The Sugar Mill is not generally suited to children under 11 years of age. We may accept a strictly limited number of children.

A deposit of 50% is required at time of booking for all stays. On all inclusive and packages the balance is due 30 days before arrival.

Deposits less an administration fee of \$100 and credit card charges are refundable only if cancelled 30 days or more prior to arrival.

Between 30 days before and the date of arrival the balance of 50% is taken. Once the full amount is taken there are no refunds.

Credit card fees are non refundable at any time.

**GUESTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO BUY TRIP INSURANCE**

Notice of 60 days required on Christmas and New Years reservations.

For Group/Special Occasion Reservations, the Sugar Mill has a minimum 60 day prior to arrival cancellation policy in order to issue a full refund.

All cancellations are subject to a \$100 cancellation charge.

Meals, beverages, hotel service charges, room taxes, airport transfers are not included unless otherwise specified. BVI has an airport departure tax of \$20 per person and a ferry departure tax of \$20 per person payable on arrival.

There is also an environmental tax of \$10 per person payable on arrival.

Laundry service is available at an additional charge.
